Rigless intervention on subsea completed wells has been around for nearly two decades, but the recent increased interest in this technology has been driven by a number of factors. Firstly, the high price of oil has encouraged operators to carry out well intervention work that has often been pushed to the backburner. Secondly, the drive to increase recovery rates from subsea wells has encouraged operators to look at this technology. Also, with the increased use of subsea wells in new deepwater arenas and the general shortage of rigs has made operators consider the alternatives.

This one day technical event will look at political issues, operator strategies and current and new technology. The programme includes an overview of the UK sector prospects by renowned oil field economist Prof Alex Kemp; a look at the UK's new stewardship initiative; presentations by Statoil and Shell on what they have done and plan to do on their subsea wells; and technology papers from Cal Dive, FMC, Expro, WellCut, BJ Services, and others.
